

LAUNCHING THE NEW NRSB CERTIFICATE-HOLDERS ONLY PORTAL

The National Radon Safety Board (NRSB) is pleased to announce the new “Certificate Holders Only” portal. If you are currently an NRSB-certified Professional, you have free access to the portal and the information within it.

The information/documents within the portal are divided into 3 categories – *Resources & Tools*; *Additional Learning*; and *Business Success*. We have based this on repeated requests from our Certificate Holders and are starting slowly with minimal content, but we already have additional items pending to add to this library by the end of January 2026, including two videos for the “Additional Learning” section.

Looking forward, the portal will evolve to be an interactive tool for our certificate-holders. We are planning for you to have access to your own NRSB records/profile, including a transcript of all the courses you have submitted for continuing education. By the end of the second quarter, the portal will be used for uploading renewal documents, pending our review. In the future, we are considering the possibility of including a discussion board for all of you to exchange information and/or seek input from your peers for especially challenging situations.

Simply go to our website, click on the “menu”, hover over the “For Professionals” tab, and then click on the “Certificate Holders Login” at the bottom of the list.
